Respite Care

St David's Hospice Care are pleased to be able to offer the option of respite care to patients and carers that are known to our service in our new Hospice on Blackett Avenue in Malpas, Newport.

Two beds are available for patients who are medically stable, as agreed by their GP, and for a specific pre-arranged period of time that can be up to a maximum of two weeks.

You will be required to bring with you enough medication to last throughout your stay.

Should you need to be reviewed by a GP during your stay or should your medication require changing this will be undertaken by the doctors at St David's Clinic in Newport who can attend to you.

On admission you will be admitted by one of St David's Hospice Care's senior nurses on the unit and reviewed by a GP from St David's Clinic.

Your discharge date will have been pre-agreed and transport home will be arranged by the staff caring for you.



Fee

All of our care is completely free of charge to patients.

What will I need to bring?

You will have your own en-suite so please bring any personal items to make your stay with us as comfortable as possible.

Visiting

We have open visiting at the hospice.

Café

We have a café in the hospice that patients, relatives and friends can use.

What happens if my condition changes whilst I am in?

Our nurses and doctors will discuss with you your wishes and the most appropriate plan will be put into place.
