INTRODUCTION

St David's Hospice Care will be arresting, charging and putting on trial some well-known business people in the area who, if found guilty of their entirely fictitious crimes, will have to raise a bail of £795 each to be set free.

The idea is simple – participants get locked away for the day in the cells at Newport market underground, whilst they, their friends, colleagues, and supporters aim to raise the bail needed to get them out.

WHAT IS INVOLVED



On the day the accused will be arrested and put on trial for their fictitious crimes which include crimes against fashion, making the worst cuppa and worst office singing voice!

The criminals will then be escorted to the cells underground Newport Market, for pictures to use on social media to help aid their bail.





They will then be required to use their contacts to raise the funds to enable them to reach their bail amount.

It is possible to start the fundraising before you are arrested to ease the fundraising on the day. You could organise a coffee morning at the office!





Prisoners will be fed throughout the day. At the end of the day, friends and colleagues are welcome to join us for the closing court ceremony.
