

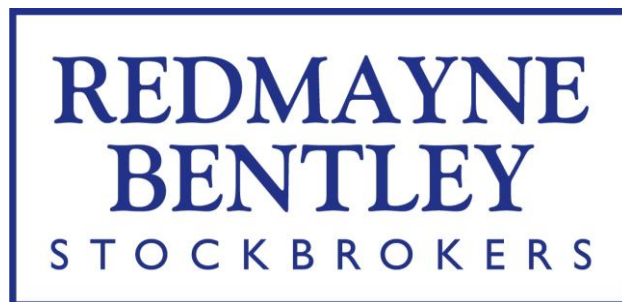

About St. David's Foundation Hospice Care

St. David's Foundation Hospice Care was established in 1979 and provides free community-based hospice care to people with cancer or any other life threatening illness living within Caerphilly, Monmouthshire, Newport, Torfaen and more recently South Powys.

In addition to the four teams of Clinical Nurse Specialists, St. David's Foundation has a 'Hospice at Home' team of nurses and healthcare assistants who provide hands-on care and support. Further support is provided by our Family Support Team, comprising of social workers, welfare rights advisers, bereavement support, children's bereavement support and complementary therapists. We also have three Day Hospices, one near Pontypool, one in Ystrad Mynach and one in Brecon, as well as two Resource Centres, one in Caldicot and one in Monmouth.

St. David's Foundation Hospice Care provides patients with real choice about where they receive their care and where they spend their final days and last year we cared for 2,786 patients and their families. Our expenditure is in the region of £5.4 million p.a. and, as we receive only 20% of this funding from the NHS we rely heavily on the generosity of local companies.

How to Donate Shares

Simply fill in the attached donation coupon and send it to Redmayne-Bentley LLP (Newport) with your share certificate(s) and crest transfer form (which you will need to request beforehand)

You can also donate shares that are held in a nominee account. Please contact Redmayne-Bentley LLP (Newport) or ask your own stockbroker or agent to contact them to arrange this. Once the transfer of your shares is complete, they will be added to the other shares donated to St. David's Foundation. The shares received will be regularly sold through private client stockbrokers Redmayne-Bentley LLP (Newport), who make no commission charge to St. David's Foundation Hospice Care or to the donor for the use of this service.

Other Important Information

1. Lost certificates: you will need to get a replacement certificate in order to donate your shares. The company's registrars will be able to help you do this. You will find their details on dividend vouchers and other information relating to your shares, or alternatively contact Redmayne-Bentley LLP (Newport) on 01633 246179. For small holdings, there is usually no charge for duplicate certificates.
2. If a sole shareholder has died, please send a copy of the grant of probate, along with your donation. If a joint shareholder has died, no further documents are required. The death must be registered with the company's registrars first by sending them a sealed copy of the grant of probate and certified copy of the death certificate. Until this is done, they cannot be transferred into the Foundation's nominee account.
3. Some certificates may be invalid or unable to be readily transferred. If a transfer proves to be impractical, the certificate will be returned to you with an explanation.
4. Redmayne-Bentley LLP cannot accept responsibility for share certificates sent in the post, and the shares will still be registered in your name until the transfer is completed.
5. Data Protection Act 1998: Any personal data provided by you to us at any time will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. We will mainly use your personal data with the provision of our services to you, but may also use it to contact you in connection with other services. We will not provide information to organisations outside Redmayne-Bentley LLP, its associated companies and our branch network, without your consent; unless we are obliged to do so by law.

Tax Information

Donating shares to St. David's Foundation Hospice Care gives rise neither to a gain nor a loss for Capital Gains Tax purposes. If you are a UK taxpayer, you can claim income tax relief on the value of most stocks and securities when you donate them to charity.
